

Standards for Image Delivery

- Image format: JPEG (standardized).
- Delivering very high resolution images on the Web poses new challenges.
- Image delivery: we need higher-level standardization.




IIIF (International Image Interoperability Framework)


- IIIF (http://iiif.io/) is now widely used in humanities-related communities, including libraries, museums and archives.
- 1. Image API: Delivery of single images.
- 2. Presentation API: Delivery of a set of images (e.g. books) with metadata
- We extended IIIF APIs to three directions:
 Curation, Timeline, and Cursor.



Curation on the Viewer



- We define curation as selection and ordering of interesting objects from the collection.
- '■' (13) is a tool to draw a rectangle on a canvas to select the region of interest.
- '☆' (6) is a "favorite" button to keep interesting objects (a whole image or a region)






Digital Silk Road: Digital Archive of Toyo Bunko Rare Books

User-Generated Content

Traditional IIIF

- Collection of Manifest.
- Image repository provides authoritative resources, reflecting the physical structure of the material.
- IIIF is findable only by standard metadata.

IIIF Curation

- Collection of Range.
- (Crowdsourcing) users create personal resources, offering richer context for diverse interpretation.
- IIIF may be findable by user-generated context.
